Currahee Club, a golf, lake, and mountain community on Lake Hartwell in the mountains of northeast Georgia, has made a revolutionary departure from an activities director to a director of adventure, an all-encompassing job purely for the recreational activities of members and guests.

Ty Wheeler, formerly a member of the U. S. Air Force's Special Operations command, will fill that office, designed to help members and guests get the most out of life in and around the community.

Wheeler will arrange trips to such spots as his favorite swimming hole, to good canoe waters, and to the best places to catch trout. He can also put together all-night slumber parties for children in the club's teepees or set up a ride in the club's hot air balloon at sunset.

Meanwhile, construction has begun on Currahee Club's 48,000-square foot clubhouse overlooking the golf course's first hole and views of Lake Hartwell and the surrounding mountains.

Located in Toccoa, Ga., 90 minutes from Atlanta and an hour from Greenville, S.C. off Highway 17, the clubhouse will feature a 120-seat dining room and cocktail lounge, billiards room, golf shop, locker rooms, covered porches with mountain and lake views, and a central gathering area with vaulted ceilings and two fireplaces.

The clubhouse will resemble a turn-of-the-century mountain lodge with such features as a 100-year-old Irish bar front in the men's locker room.
